Regular Meeting
July 8, 2019

Meeting was brought to order at 7:00 P.M. with a motion by David Galvan, second by Darcy Smith.
Motion Carried.

Additions to the agenda were Disk Golf, Community building update, roof repair, Dustin Murk requests and information.

Motion by David Galvan, second by Dennis Kelley to approve the printed list of bills and the minutes as written. Motion Carried.

Present at the meeting were Mayor Ward Stockamp, David Galvan, Darcy Smith, Judith Swagerty, Dennis Kelley, and City treasurer Betty Davis was also present. Trudi Rathbun was absent. There were no visitors.

The disk golf course was discussed. Ward talked to Chris Rose who said that he is planning to install it very soon.

Roof repair on the city office was discussed. An email was sent out from the roofers that stated they would be starting work soon, weather permitting.

Electric at the rodeo grounds was discussed. No information from Jeff Scheele yet.

The new Rec board by laws were discussed. Motion by David Galvan, second by Darcy Smith to approve the Rec Advisory board bylaws as corrected at the June 24th meeting. Motion Carried.

Tires for the Kubota were discussed. Council wants Dustin Murk to get 6-ply tires at Peerless and have them put on.

Dustin Murk would like to get a flow meter so the city can get an accurate record of water lost and used. The cost is \$850.00. Motion by Judith Swagerty, second by David Galvan to purchase a flow meter for \$850.00 Motion Carried.

Dustin Murk would like to re-rock two alleys and purchase some rock for several areas that are settling. Two loads of road rock will cost \$1850.00 and two loads of alley rock is \$1340.00. Motion by David Galvan, second by Dennis Kelley to purchase two loads of road rock for \$1850.00 and two loads of alley rock for \$1340.00. Motion Carried.

Council discussed the leak by the recycling center. There have been three leaks in three years. Dustin Murk will be asked to get a quote on fixing the problem.
