

ORDINANCE NO. 405

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 1, ARTICLE 10 OF THE BENNINGTON CITY CODE PERTAINING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE BENNINGTON VOLUNTEER AMBULANCE SERVICE AND ADVISORY COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, Chapter 1, Article 10 of the Bennington City Code establishes a volunteer ambulance service, which consists of a director, an assistant director, an advisory council, and emergency medical technicians and first responders sufficient to meet the emergency medical needs of the service area (hereinafter collectively referred to as the “Ambulance Services”); and


WHEREAS, the Governing Body has determined that the public interest is best served by the termination of the City’s provision of the Ambulance Services as a municipal function, in anticipation of the provision of the Ambulance Services by Ottawa County, Kansas, by and through its Fire District #4, County of Ottawa, Kansas; **SO NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the City of Bennington, Kansas:

Section 1. That Chapter I, Article 10 of the Bennington City Code is repealed.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective and in full force from and after ~~12:00 noon~~ October 1st 2018, or the earliest date thereafter, following its passage by the governing body and publication in the official City newspaper.
