The city council voted at the April 13th meeting to go ahead and have free dump days as originally planned since the county cancelled dump days for Ottawa county. The city is picking up the extra cost of this since county is not involved. We will also be accepting tires at the city shop. There will be a trailer to put them on. Please put your items in the appropriate dumpsters and not on the ground. As always, nothing with freon is allowed in the dumpsters. This dump day is for the residents of the City of Bennington ONLY.

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY

Any contractor doing work on your home, must be licensed through the City of Bennington and provide Liability insurance with no less than \$300,00 coverage per occurrence and \$600,000 in aggregate. A license is \$25.00 per year and is not pro-rated. It will expire on December 1st of each calendar year per ordinance #408. A application is available on the web site www.cityofbennington.com It will also serve as the license once it is signed by the city clerk. A copy of this license must be on the job site during the project. If you would like more information on the regulations, the ordinance #408, in its entirety is on the website or on file in the city office. Violations of this ordinance will result in a fine of \$100.00 per occurrence. If you are a contractor, please get your license fill out the application ASAP!
