COMPLIANCE NEWS

Dustin Murk and I are going to be looking at yards for the next couple months. Mowing needs to be kept up, weeds need to be taken care of, trees and bushes need trimmed, rogue trees need to be removed from foundations, around other trees and in yards. Anything sitting in the yard that is mowed around needs to be trimmed as well. No tall weeds. We will also be looking for junk or trash that needs to be taken care of and will let you know about that too. Thank you for taking care of these things as soon as possible. We appreciate it!

ATTENTION

Spring dump days were successful. For the Fall dump days, things will be done differently. We are in the process of putting rocked pads by the Recycling center to hold the dumpsters for the next dump days. This event will be staffed from this point forward. More information will be given closer to the next dump day.

SPECIAL PERMIT

A special permit is needed to keep any fowl, rabbits, goats etc. on your property within the city limits. There is no charge for this permit, but the approval of every neighbor within 150 feet is required and then the permit is taken to the city council after the enclosures are inspected by the animal control officer. If you are a renter or a renter lives 150 feet of you, the landlord of the property also needs to sign the form. You are not allowed to bring the animals into town until the approval has been obtained and the inspection completed. Anyone who has these types of animals need to renew the permit annually.
