Regular Meeting
September 28, 2020

Meeting was brought to order at 7:00 P.M. with a motion by Dennis Kelley, second by David Galvan. Motion Carried.

Additions to the agenda were City Clean up (Dennis), Burt's trailers (Trudi), 113 S. Lincoln, untagged vehicles (Brian), Watters no parking signs (Ward).

Motion by David Galvan, second by Brian Davidson to approve the printed list of bills and the minutes as written. Motion Carried.
