Thank you to everyone who have brought in proof of rabies for your pets and purchased 2021 pet tags. There are several people who have not provided the city with the information to keep on file and you need to do it. I must keep a copy of these in my office. As of May 31st, a pet license is \$16.00 per animal. Please get this taken care of immediately. March 1st was the deadline. If you have a new pet, you have 30 days or if it is a puppy, until it is old enough to get a rabies shot. The cost for a pet tag is still \$3.00 for a new pet.

During the whole Covid issue, there were no penalties added to late bills as directed by our Governor. These restrictions have all been lifted and bills are still due by the 15th of the month as they always have been. A 20% penalty will be added if your bill is not paid by the 15th of June unless you have made other arrangements personally with the council or in some cases, with me.
