Regular Meeting
6/14/2021

Meeting was brought to order at 7:00 p.m. with a motion by David Galvan, second by Dennis Kelley.
Motion Carried.

There were no additions to the agenda.

Motion by David Galvan, second by Brian Davidson to approve the printed list of bills and the minutes as written. Motion Carried.

Sidney Reeves daycare located at the Wagner property was discussed. Council said she is good to go on the daycare because it meets C3 uses under "church", which daycares are generally included in. Nothing further needs to be done other than Sidney Reeves paying a connection fee to the city to start service.

The spray park was discussed. Council told Ward Stockamp to go ahead and get plans from the company for the park.

Cord Gwennap's resignation was approved. Motion by David Galvan, second by Brian Davidson to accept Cord Gwennap's resignation from the city council as of July 1st 2021. Motion Carried.
