I am looking for a city treasurer/office assistant to work up to 20 hours per week in the City office. The person hired for this position would eventually be trained to take my place if I am taking sick or vacation leave so extra hours will be required at times as well as opening the office at 8:00 am. Job duties include daily deposits, going to the bank and post office, entering meter readings, preparing water bills for mailing, and balancing bank statements. Must have data entry experience and accurate ability, solid math skills, be able to multi-task, have good organizational skills, and experience working with the public. Cleaning, running errands and other various duties will also be required. If you are interested, please come to the city office from 8 am to 4 pm to apply.

The City of Bennington will also be holding our free dumpster days for residents of the city only from Saturday October 2nd until Sunday October 10th. The dumpsters will be in the new location by the recycle center. Hours are M-F 8:00 am to 6:00 pm. Sat and Sun 8:00 am to 5pm. No Tires will be accepted. Please place items in the correct dumpsters. There will be one for household items, One for metal and one for wood. Do not dump on the ground.

Mayor Ward Stockamp will be picking up E-waste on curbs Saturday October 9th in the early afternoon. If you have any computers, televisions, any electronic equipment that needs hauled away, he will pick it up and take it to Salina for you. You must have it out early so he can just pick it up from your curbside. No televisions larger than two people can carry please.



Ottawa county free landfill days will be October 4th through the 8th. No tires will be accepted. Items for the Landfill should be sorted. Household trash should be bagged and put in trash bins located inside the entrance. There is a place for metal and a place for wood. Save time and have things sorted before you arrive. Transporting waste that is not bagged must be covered or tied down to prevent loss of material along roads. Hours are M-F 8:30 am to 12:00 and 1:00 to 4:30pm. Saturday-8:00 am to 1:00 pm. NO TIRES.
