

Bennington City Council  
Regular Meeting  
10/11/2021

The meeting was brought to order at 7:00 pm with a motion from David Galvan, second by Dennis Kelley. Motion Carried.

Additions to the agenda were: City generators, e-waste, attorney update and spray park.

Motion by Judith Swagerty, second by David Galvan to approve the minutes as written and the printed list of bills. Motion Carried.

The spray park was discussed. Adrienne Luthi will contact Chuck Kiefer to give us an updated quote for the new location and the changes in the Rain Deck quote.
