Thank you to everyone who took advantage of our annual pet clinic on Saturday the 19th. We had a lot of people and it went very smoothly as usual. If you did not make it, tags are now \$4.00 each for the first week of March. They will continue to go up a dollar each week. If you did not tag your dogs last year, and have not been here to take care of the situation, you will receive a citation to appear in court. Bring proof of rabies vaccination and we will get your tags up to date. If we are not here, place your proof of rabies vaccination in the drop box outside along with a check or cash for \$4.00 for each animal March 1-7 and we will mail them to you if we happen to be closed. The office is open Monday through Friday 8:00 am until 4:00 pm and is open through the lunch hour Monday through Friday as well. We understand many do not get off until 5:00 pm or after. That is one of the reasons we put in a drop box, for your convenience. If you have gotten a new pet, and it is not old

enough to vaccinate, you are fine and can bring in the paperwork when it is old enough to do so. We appreciate all of you who have gotten this taken care of. It is very important that the city clerk has on file at all times rabies vaccinations for any and all pets requiring one in town. If you have pets you have failed to report to the office, please call and make arrangements with me immediately and I will work with you. Thank you!!!!

ATTENTION

We are continuing to work on inoperable vehicles sitting around in the city. Inoperable includes untagged vehicles as well as vehicles that do not start and run.
