Being proactive could save you a lot of money in the long run. Any water going through a meter is the home owner or renter's responsibility. Running toilets can also cause many thousands of gallons to go through your meter. Check your toilets often to make sure they are shutting off properly.

The 2023 animal clinic was a success! Thanks to all who took advantage of the veterinary services and paid for your tags for 2023! The deadline for tags is March 1<sup>st</sup>. After March 1<sup>st</sup>, there is a dollar a week added to the \$3.00 charge. Thank you for your prompt attention to this matter. Please bring proof of rabies to the office to get your tags if we do not have a current one on file from you. We must keep a copy of proof of rabies vaccinations in the office at all times. If you have not provided one and purchased a city tag by March 1<sup>st</sup>, a citation to appear in court can be issued to you. Please do not forget to get this done. Thank you!!!!
