Reminder that animal tags for 2024 will need to be purchased after the 1^{st} of the year. We will announce the date of the annual animal clinic in January.

We are still looking for someone to run the Bennington Swimming Pool for the 2024 season. Please call the City Office at 785-488-3767. Please spread the word so we can open the pool next year.

Water and Sewer rates for the billing January 1st 2024 have changed. Kansas Rural Water looked at our rates and refigured them based on the cost of supporting our water and sewer funds. The new rates will be the same for everyone, including residential and business's regardless of the meter size. A minimum bill for the first 1000 gallons will be \$21.47, and every 1000 gallons after that will be \$6.38 and the Sewer rates will be a flat rate of \$24.03 as suggested by the KRWA study. This represents an approximate \$8.00 increase a month.
