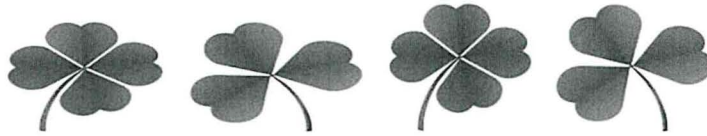

The animal clinic was a success, but there are still many residents who have not tagged their animals and brought proof of rabies to keep on file at the city office. Animal tags will increase \$1.00 per week beginning March 1st. Thank you for your prompt attention to this matter.

Compliance will be working again on inoperable vehicles this month. All vehicles in the city limit must be tagged and insured as well as being in working order if they are not inside a garage or shed. You may contact Jeff Scheele at 785-452-8079 if you have any questions. Thank you.

We are having problems with residents dumping trash at the limb pile as well as at the city shop, not only in the dumpster, but also on the ground by the dumpster. The limb pile is not for trash, wood pallets, or other wooden items. The state can and will shut down the limb pile if people continue to illegally dump there. Someone is also using the city trash dumpster and also dumping on the ground in front of it as well. If you are caught, you will be written a citation for illegal dumping and you will have to appear in court. The dumpster at the shop is for the City's trash only not for the public. We are in the process of installing cameras to monitor areas in the city. Please also remember trash bags must be removed from yard waste. Take them with you and dispose of them in your own household trash. Thank you.

Spring dump days will be the first full week of May. If you have junk on your property that needs to be cleaned up, this would be a good time to do it.
