Regular Meeting
September 22, 2025

The meeting was brought to order at 7:00 p.m. with a motion from Dennis Kelley, second by Brian Davidson. Motion Carried.

There were no additions to the agenda.

Motion by Laura Bowers, second by Jeff Scheele to approve the minutes as written and the printed list of bills with the exception of Davidson Construction check to be changed from \$4200.00 to \$2400.00. Motion Carried.
