

Bennington City Council
Regular Meeting
06/22/2026

The meeting was brought to order at 7:00 p.m. with a motion by Brian Davidson, second by Karl Serrien. Motion Carried.

Additions to the agenda were blocking off Lincoln to Parker on Burlington St. for the 4th, Mauch Property, Twin Valley.

Motion by Dustin Murk, second by Don Weiland to approve the printed list of bills and the minutes as written. Motion Carried.

Present at the meeting were Mayor Ward Stockamp, Brian Davidson, Karl Serrien, Dustin Murk, Don Weiland and Jeff Scheele. Amy Stevens and Mark Walker were also present. Visitors were Chris Rose and Jeff Jackson.

Golf Carts/ATV's were tabled until the next meeting, pending rough draft of ordinance amendment.

Recycle center was tabled until next meeting pending prices.

The council agreed to purchase 2 lounge chairs and 4 deck chairs for the pool.

Bleachers for the ball field were discussed. Chris Rose asked if the city would pay for the bleachers so they could be installed quickly and the Bennington Youth Diamond Sports will reimburse the city when the grant money gets here. Motion by Brian Davidson, second by Karl Serrien to approve ordering and payment of the bleachers for Youth Diamond Sports, with the agreement the city will be reimbursed once the grant money gets here. Motion Carried.

The budget was reviewed, Motion by Don Weiland, second by Jeff Scheele to approve NOT exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate for the 2027 budget year. Motion Carried.

The council discussed getting a backup button for the siren in case the electricity goes out. Motion by Don Weiland, second by Brian Davidson to approve the Blue Valley quote of \$960.75 for a backup button to be installed on the siren. Motion Carried.

Motion by Karl Serrien, second by Jeff Scheele to adjourn the meeting at 8:11 p.m. Motion Carried.
